

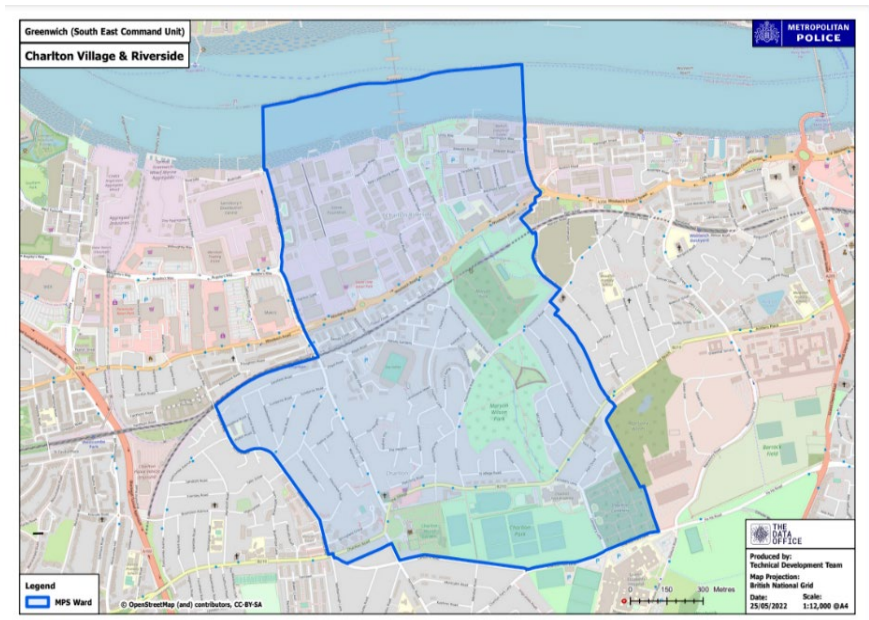

Charlton Village & Riverside Ward

Over the last month ward officers have been continuing to deal with a range of ASB issues across the ward.

In response to reports of **Anti-Social Behaviour** we have been patrolling the hotspot areas such as: Victoria Way, Thorntree Road, Valley Grove, Charlton Church Lane, Wellington Gardens, Charlton Park, Maryon Park, Charlton Station, Barney Close and The Village.

We are continuing to help members of the public with reassurance visits especially for theft of motor vehicles, shoplifting, hate crimes and burglaries.



A planned patrol is ongoing on Maryon Park and Charlton Park, following some ASB and indecent exposure incidents. This represents one of the most important priorities in the ward and we will continue to keep the area safe for everyone in the community.

Other main priorities for the first trimester of the year are: Ramadan mosque patrols and police surveillance around drug dealing hotspots areas.

Officers have conducted numerous patrols around specific areas in Charlton regarding vehicle crime reports. Charlton Safer neighbour Team have provided local residents guidance on how to prevent and protect their motor vehicles from theft. Police have recovered a number of stolen vehicles thanks to intel gathering in specific targeted area. The purpose is to develop new intelligence and create new effective actions to prevent this type of crime happening on the ward.
